

About My Number Card

What you can do with My Number Card

- The front side of the My Number Card can be used as <u>an identity</u> verification document with a face photo in the same way as a driver's license.
- My number (individual number) is written on the back of the My Number Card, and <u>it can be used as a document to confirm your My Number</u> when performing procedures in the fields of social security and tax.
- By using the electronic certificate installed in the IC chip of the My Number Card, <u>you can apply for administrative procedures online and</u> <u>obtain various certificates at convenience stores.</u>

Expiration date of My Number Card



If you have a period of stay, the expiration date of your My Number Card will be the same. <u>If you have extended your</u> <u>period of stay, you will need to apply to renew the expiration</u> date of your My Number Card at the municipal office.

 If you do not have a period of stay, the validity period is the 10th birthday from the date of issue of the card for those aged 18 or over, and the 5th birthday from the date of issue for persons under 18 years of age.

When there is a change in name, address, etc.

 If the information on your My Number Card changes due to moving, marriage, etc., please bring your My Number Card to the municipal office. Write your new address and name on the card.

In case of loss of My Number Card



If you lose your My Number Card, immediately <u>call</u> <u>the number below and suspend the My Number Card</u> <u>function.</u>

My Number Card call center 20120-95-0178

- <u>After that, please go through the procedures for loss at the municipal</u> office.
- If the card is found after the My Number Card has been suspended, the suspension can be canceled at the municipal office.
- If you have lost or damaged your My Number Card and wish to have it reissued, you will need to apply for reissuance at the municipal office. In that case, a fee of 1,000 yen will be charged for reissuance.

Precautions for handling my number card

- Be careful of high temperatures, physical forces, and strong magnetism.
- Do not get it wet with chemicals or liquids as the surface may peel off.
 Also, do not let it come into direct contact with vinyl chloride products (pass cases, etc.).
- If you do not pay attention to the above, a 1,000 yen fee will be charged for reissuance of a card due to a malfunction with the IC chip or magnetic stripe.

About electronic certificates

Electronic certificate and PIN

- The following PIN are set for My Number Cards.
- Be careful not to let others know your PIN.

PIN type		Usage	
①署名用電子証明書 electronic certificate for signature	alphanumeric 6 to 16 digits	When filing electronically on the Internet	
②利用者証明用電子証明書 Electronic certificate for user proof	4 digit number	When using online services such as issuing certificates at convenience stores or logging in to Mynaportal	
③住民基本台帳用 for Basic Resident Register	4 digit number	When completing procedures using your My Number card at the municipal office	
④券面事項入力補助用 For assisting card information entry	4 digit number	When using name, address, date of birth, and gender as text data	

%The same number can be set for PIN 2 to 4.

Electronic certificate expiration date

- The expiration date of the electronic certificate is from <u>the card issue</u> <u>date to the 5th birthday or the expiration date of the My Number Card,</u> whichever is earlier.
- Electronic certificates can be renewed at the municipal office from $\frac{3}{2}$

<u>months before the expiration date.</u>

PIN lock and reset

 Please note that if you enter the wrong PIN five times in a row for the electronic certificate for signature and three times for the electronic certificate for user proof, you will not be able to use the electronic certificate.
 If you have locked it, you can reset your PIN at the municipal office.

When there is a change in name, address, etc.

 If there is a change in name, address, etc. due to moving, marriage, etc., <u>the electronic certificate for signature will be automatically</u> <u>invalidated</u>. In addition to each procedure, please follow the procedure for issuing an electronic certificate.

How to use electronic certificates

- When performing procedures using electronic certificates such as e-tax and Mynaportal at home, you will need a smartphone or computer and an IC card reader/writer.
- In the case of smartphones, a model that supports the reading of My Number Cards (IC cards) is required.
- In the case of a personal computer, installation of "利用者クライアントソフト(user client software)" and an IC card reader/writer compatible with the public personal authentication service are required.
 ※Please refer to the public personal authentication service portal site for details on advance preparation.


Convenience store issuance of certificate

- Electronic certificates for smartphones are available at some convenience stores.
